DALTON'S RUTROW in the second flight while in the two path, angled out to be four wide when moving to challenge exiting the turn, put a head in front when straightened for home, drove clear. BERABERABERA in mid pack in the two path, three wide into the lane, steered out wider past the furlong marker, rallied for the place. MIRACLE MACK hesitated to be off slow, improved inside of traffic late in the turn, shifted out, lost whip midstretch, missed the place. MONEYSTRIKE forwardly placed, came three wide into the lane, had little for the winner the final furlong, weakened to lose the place. SECRET HONOR off a step slow, raced back, showed some belated interest to improve position. WELCOMETOARKANSAS dueled up front closest to the inside for a half, faltered entering the stretch. CHANGING TIMES dueled up front while in the two path, also gave way when the real running began at the head of the lane.

BET ALL THE GOLD in the second flight outside, four wide through the turn, tired in the drive. YOUNG JONESBORO lacked speed outside, four wide into the turn, remained back. MR. BENNY failed to menace three wide. IT'S A RAINY DAY finished early while four wide. TARPS STORM off slow, trailed throughout in showing little.
