SIR HENRY OLIVER a bit restless in the gate, stalked the two leaders off the inside, ranged up four wide to challenge late in the final turn, put a head in front upper stretch and edged clear under steady handling. WOLF TOOTH dueled up front while closest to but not on the rail, continued to alternate up front into and through the final turn, raced on equal terms with the winner upper stretch then could not match strides, edged clear for the second spot. CATTLE BARON alternated up front on the outside, continued to vie far turn, came into the stretch between the top two and began to weaken. SIOUX EMPIRE bothered when floated out to be five wide early in the first turn, continued outside, went evenly the stretch in lacking a serious closing response. SPOOKY ACTION broke out and bobbled, trailed early as a result just off the rail, continued to see them all the middle half mile, came four wide for the drive and improved position by passing mostly tiring rivals. FLEETWOOD JACK in mid pack firsts turn off the inside, bothered slightly midway on that turn, angled in, raced in tight quarters and checked up in some traffic onto the backstretch, went one paced thereafter while in the two path through the final turn. AMORE off slowly, dropped to the inside early in the first turn, saved ground through in failing to threaten. REBEL CHARLIE a bit rank while getting out in the first turn to bother a couple of outer rivals, was finished after a half.
