## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

SHE'S SO COAL took control after the start, set a quick early pace, bit of a breather middle half mile, quickly opened up late final turn, ran rivals off their feet in a dominating performance while being kept to task late. MISS CHOCOLATTE lacked early foot, began to move off the inside far turn, came three wide for the drive, continued to rally to be clear for the place, never a threat to the winner. SECRET SLEW broke in to aid in tightening up an outer rival, raced in the second flight while three wide, moved inside far, came back out into the lane, finished up best of the rest. SHRIMP COOKIE off a step slow, devoid of any speed for five furlongs, came four wide into the lane, staged a mild rally to improve slightly. LILMISSINDEPENDET in mid pack while outside in the early going, moved toward the inside for the second bend, failed to muster a closing response. INUIT moved closer before a half, chased the winner through the second turn, weakened in the drive. SHE'S MY LAST CALL broke in to help pinch C NOTE GIA at the break, raced closest to the winner in prompting the issue for six furlongs and gave way. C NOTE GIA pinched at the start, was never a factor. TALLAHASSEE rank early, forward for a half, stopped in the far turn. VALESKA'S PROMISE was finished early. B'S LUCK stopped after a half, far back, jogged in.
