FIVE DREAMS dueled two deep from the outside and edged clear late under all out pressure. YULETIDE GALLOP dueled along the inside, dug in and narrowly held the place position. MASK PATROL off a step slow, hard ridden from the inside near the quarter pole, shifted out five wide through the drive and finished gamely to the wire. BROTHER RICE stalked the pace, moved up six wide through the upper stretch, shifted in through the stretch run and was even late with no late bid. GOING AT IT raced two to three wide around the far turn and never was a factor. COMMINGLING saved ground and never threatened. IN SKY WE TRUST off a step slow and failed to respond.
