PALM ISLAND pressed the pace from the inside in the early stages, backed off a couple lengths before entering the turn, began closing in three wide through the turn to enter the stretch in a competitive position, took charge at the eighth and drove clear. TATUM broke swiftly for a ground saving lead, began asking at the three sixteenths but grudgingly gave way to the winner at the eighth, held for the place honors. LIEUTENANT STAN settled off the pace, split foes midway through the turn and closed in to be just behind the pace in entering the stretch, brushed with SUNDAY GIFT approaching the sixteenth, just held for the show award. SUNDAY GILT tracked the pace between runners, shifted out four wide entering the stretch, brushed with LIEUTENANT STAN approaching the sixteenth. EDDIEMUSH settled back to be the early trailer, split tiring foes in the stretch. PENTATONIC tracked the pace four wide, backed off the pace through the turn, lacked response in the stretch. CALLIN MY NAME was rated on the inside, slowly retreated throughout, trailed by the eighth.
