LORD'S LADY bobbled then broke out at the start and crowded outer rivals, settled in the early stages and trailed to the half-mile, advanced two wide and between foes into the far turn, angled to the four path into upper stretch, responded well in the drive then surged in deep stretch, took command in the final yards and held late for the win. PRINCESS KALAMOH broke alertly and sent for the early lead, showed the way to the first turn then carved out moderate fractions approaching the half-mile, met the bid of PERSIAN at the quarter marker and dug in into the stretch, shook free of that foe into the final sixteenth, was collared by the winner in deep stretch and bested the rest. PERSIAN rated off of the early lead then stalked PRINCESS KALAMOH to the backstretch, mounted a two wide bid into the far turn and vied for the lead into the lane, battled PRINCESS KALAMOH into the final furlong, was repelled at the sixteenth-marker and yielded to the top pair late, while well clear of the rest for third. ECLIPTICAL GINA was allowed to settle while saving ground into the first turn, well placed while along the rail nearing the half-mile, kept an inside path to the far turn, lacked the needed response into the stretch and flattened out in the late stages. TEMPTING LADY crowded and took up at the start, settled while widest to the first turn, coaxed four wide to the half-mile pole, gained ground and chased three wide into the far turn, floated four wide to upper stretch, could not find more into the lane and gave way. SECRET JOURNEY crowded and pinched at the start, recovered to be forwardly placed while three wide into the first turn, tracked the pace between foes heading to the half-mile pole, got shuffled a bit into the far turn then lost ground nearing the quarter marker, trailed into upper stretch and could not find more in the late stages.
