QUIET CITY quickly assumed a ground saving lead, came under pressure from KELLY'S INTO LUCK up the backstretch, began to pull away from the field in the far turn, kept on task down the stretch for a very convincing victory. ADAMISCASHINGIN settled off the pace, weaved up a few places in the far turn, entered the stretch in the three path to pick off a couple more foes but lugged towards the inside at the three sixteenths, no match for the winner but was clear of the rest for the place honors. KOOL KAY settled off the pace, trailed after the first turn, showed a willing effort in the stretch to improve for the show award. RUGGED SMILE broke a step slow, trailed through the first turn, steadily advanced along the inside, shifted out to the three path in the upper stretch and flattened out. KELLY'S INTO LUCK ranged up through the first turn to stalk the pace setter from the three path, unable to keep up with the leader as she pulled away in the far turn, took a slight hold at the three sixteenths to avoid ADAMISCASHINGIN, weakened then on. MARLAS DREAM chased the pace until retreating midway through the far turn.
