PAGEANT PRINCESS raced off the pace inside, advanced inside entering the turn, angled out at the top of the lane, rallied two wide, took over and kicked clear under urging. THE FURMANATOR vied two wide for the lead, chased on the turn, came three wide into the lane and re rallied for second. BESS' CANDY raced off the pace between rivals, chased inside on the turn, altered course behind a rival at the furlong marker and closed late outside. AFTERNEATH vied inside for the lead, shook free on the turn, dueled with the winner in upper stretch and weakened late. KISSED AT DAWN was off slowly and steadied, trailed the field, rode the rail into the stretch and failed to threaten. LA LIMA broke inward, stalked the pace, chased between rivals on the turn and had no rally. STASSI raced four wide off the pace, chased three wide on the turn and tired.
