CHUCK ADAMS gained a slim lead three wide and to the inside of runners heading to the first turn, remained off the inside while handling pressure through the backstretch, was nudged clear leaving the far turn, kept on under left handed asking inside the furlong grounds and dug in tenaciously to prevail. TALLAHATCHIEBRIDGE lagged off the pace, crept up three wide and behind runners near the quarter pole, swung out well in the course leaving the three sixteenths and closed strongly to just miss. MUCHO MOJO tracked the leaders off the inside, gained four deep past the five sixteenths, had aim three wide into the lane, chased on past mid stretch then hung very late. PORCH SWING stalked towards the inside, idled near the three eighths, gained inside into the lane, lacked room soon after, altered out and closed willingly. ZAPATA (IRE) , prominent from the inside, loomed after a ground saving move past the quarter pole then flattened out. MT SURIBACHI settled off the pace, gained inside leaving the far turn, was patiently handled nearing the stretch, worked between foes in mid stretch then lacked the needed finish. HIGHLY POTENT stalked off the inside, gained five wide past the five sixteenths then came up empty. PRINCE KHOZAN edged up five wide into the first turn to attend the pace, remained well off the inside stalking near the half, failed to go on between rivals past the five sixteenths and weakened. MAJOR THOMAS , forward three wide between horses, weakened in upper stretch. DARVESH failed to menace.
