GREAT KISSER was outpaced early, advanced three to four wide on the far turn to reach contention, shifted out when INFAMOUS NONO drifted in upper stretch, then avoided the loose horse nearing the wire and held on for the victory. GENGHIS settled at the rear, steadied sharply to avoid the loose horse approaching the three-furlong pole, rallied five to six wide into the stretch and closed well to earn second. INFAMOUS NONO raced prominently three wide, ranged up to challenge nearing the quarter pole, remained in contention through midstretch, then steadied to avoid the loose horse and weakened. FIRE DOWN BELOW raced in midpack while three to four wide throughout and finished evenly. KAZ CREED set a clear early pace, dug in when challenged nearing the quarter pole, but steadied to avoid the loose horse in upper stretch and could not regain momentum. IRA THE ICON pressed the pace from second, came under urging on the far turn and weakened through the stretch. HARDY CHOICE was always three to four wide while off the pace and lacked a rally. TIME TESTED stumbled at the start, unseating the rider, continued loose, interfered with GENGHIS on the far turn and drifted across the stretch, affecting several rivals, was caught by the outsider after the finish and walked off. THERE WAS A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE START AND THE STRETCH RUN. AFTER A REVIEW, NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
