CARENTAN tucked in behind the pace, shot through along the rail to take command before the far turn, responded when challenged nearing the quarter pole and held sway despite drifting under urging. RIDLEY PARK settled near the rear while racing two wide, launched a sustained rally from the far turn, came three to four wide and stayed on well to earn the place. GOOD MAN DAN tracked the pace along the rail, lacked room until the stretch and finished well to gain third. CHAIN LIGHTNING trailed early and passed tiring rivals late. L GOLDEN BOY pressed the pace while racing three wide but weakened through the stretch. FACE THE FACTS tracked the pace three wide, advanced turning for home but failed to sustain the bid. COLOMA broke sharply to set the pace, rated kindly under outside pressure, yielded to CARENTAN before the far turn and weakened.
