ALTOBELLI tracked the pace while racing three wide, advanced to draw alongside SHOWTIME MATINEE approaching the quarter pole, dueled that rival through deep stretch and edged clear in the final yards. SHOWTIME MATINEE quickly established the lead, fought back when confronted nearing the quarter pole, dueled gamely through deep stretch and gave way grudgingly late. PATERNO briefly vied for the early lead, dropped down to the rail through the turn, and stayed on to hold third while outfinished by the top two. PETEY MOTTO broke in the air, then raced near the back, kept to task late and mildly improved. MASK PATROL was outpaced early and well behind to the turn, stayed out in the four-path and showed some mild interest in the last furlong. NIGHT PREACHER sent hard from the break but was not fast enough to contest the early pace, chased in mid-pack to the stretch, then did not have much of a late response and was overtaken and faded to the back.

PEMBERLEY settled close up behind the pace through the first turn, took command through the turn, put some distance on the rest passing the quarter pole and drew off in the stretch as much the best. OMIKAMI was hustled away to secure the rail, advanced in tandem with PEMBERLY down the backstretch, stayed on terms to the quarter pole, then was outfinished through the stretch while well clear of the others. AFRICAN ANGEL vied outside a rival for the early lead, went together with OMIKAMIN briefly, the could not keep pace when the eventual winner took command early on the backstretch, kept on to save third but was well behind the top two. E M'S TREASUREGIRL lost footing at the start and was away very awkwardly and never a factor.

KING OF THE CROSS hustled away from the outside post, pressed the pace three to four wide through the turn, took a narrow lead at the top of the stretch, then edged ahead in the final furlong to prevail. CHILLING ZENSATION moved up to press the pace three wide heading into the turn, battled on to deep stretch before yielding late. HAWKSBUURY HUSTLER was pressing the early pace between rivals, then steadied approaching the seven-sixteenths marker, came out four-wide into the stretch and kept on well to gain the minor award. JIMMY'S PAGE came away best, briefly dueled with GRINDA before being crowded entering the far turn, lost momentum after backing out, then re-rallied through the stretch to improve position. MR. MANHATTAN ducked out at the start and bumped CALL MEE REX, steadied approaching the three-furlong pole, swung five to six wide into the stretch and finished with a belated rally. GRINDA broke on top, vied inside through the turn, then gave way in the stretch. TAP THE DEVIL dropped far behind early and was never a factor. CALL MEE REX stumbled, then got bumped hard by the inside rival at the start, raced at the back, and never got involved.

WINK OF AN EYE seized the advantage early, slowed the pace down to the half-mile pole, then quickened to a clear lead through the far turn, responded to strong handling in the stretch and held clear to the wire. TORTUGA ISLAND got away well and stalked the pace two wide early, moved up to engage WINK OF AN EYE through the far turn, dueled through deep stretch before yielding in the final yards. PEACH PERFECT raced two-wide at the back for the first half-mile, then stayed on late to gain third. TRY TO MAKE CENTS was allowed to settle behind the pace, saved ground early, moved out to the two-path approaching the far turn, and advanced to be in contention for the lead turning for home, engaged DEVIL'S CAY in a spirited stretch duel and got a head in front near the wire to prevail. DEVIL'S CAY stalked the pace two-wide, launched a bid approaching the quarter pole, had a narrow lead at the turning for home, then set down with TRY TO MAKE CENTS, battled gamely, but came up short in the end. BRONX BOYS settled close up along the rail, came out to the three-path for the stretch run, was never getting to the top two, but stayed on well to gain third. NOTTURNNO was hustled away from the break, tracked three-wide in the middle of the main pack, struggled to keep up heading into the far turn, kept to task and outlasted some tired foes. GUITAR MONEY won the race into the clubhouse turn, went clear midway through the first bend, maintained a slight advantage through the far turn, then gave way in mid-stretch. SMOKE WAGON was unhurried after the start, allowed to settle at the back, and made a mild, belated rally. BERMUDA TRIANGLE angled over before the first bend but was still caught three-wide, tracked near the back, advanced to be in range heading into the far turn but weakened with three furlongs to go and faltered in the stretch.

SPINNING MUSICIAN bobbled at the start, chased the pace down the backstretch, threaded through rivals on the turn, angled out in upper stretch, and finished with a strong late kick to get up in time. ARTIST MARK pressed the early pace, kicked on with INTER MIAMI nearing the three-furlong pole, quickly opened up into the stretch, but failed to last and was caught in the final strides. GENTLE BREEZE tracked the pace, could not match the top pair late, but stayed on well for the show. INTER MIAMI was prominent in the early pace battle, duelled with ARTIST MARK through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. DOCTOR'S ORDERS was the inside horse in the early pace battle, dropped back after the half-mile pole, and faded. TOMMY THE TORCH contested the pace two-wide, then gave way midway around the turn. PURECRAZIGROOVE was always outrun. MISCHIEF WARRIOR took up after the start, advanced three-wide on the turn, but faltered in the final furlong.
