WILLY WILLY took command early and handled some outer pressure while two wide, edged clear near the half, rated kindly past the five sixteenths, denied outer foes entering the lane, responded to sharp rousing and steadily pulled away. WAR SALUTE rated forwardly, edged up three wide leaving the far turn, had aim on the winner approaching the stretch, failed to match strides but gave game chase to the wire. STONECOLDHANDSOME pressed early outside the winner then stalked four wide leaving the three eighths, chased to upper stretch then faded late. MIGRATORY , squeezed back at the break, lagged back into the turn, made a mild ground saving run near the five sixteenths but came up empty in the lane. FASTIDIOUS stalked off the inside, angled out around the turn, circled five wide into the lane, shifted in past mid stretch and weakened. MENCKE saved ground, was unable to keep pace around the turn, faltered and was eased through the final sixteenth.
