JEAN VALJEAN showed good speed from the gate and took early command, set the pace to the turn, kicked clear to upper stretch, drew off into the final furlong then was geared down late and won while in hand. FLAMINGO WAY bumped between rivals and crowded leaving the start, settled between foes to the turn, gained ground two to three wide nearing the top of the lane, ran in pursuit while four wide at mid-stretch, was no match late for the winner but held safely for the place. UNCLE DAR settled outside while never far back, tracked three to four wide into the turn, chased JEAN VALJEAN to upper stretch, couldn't keep pace with the winner into the drive, yielded to the top pair late and held for the show. FORE HARP bumped at the start then settled along the backstretch, caught in tight and steadied approaching the turn, advanced between runners nearing the quarter marker, chased into the lane then lacked the needed response to deep stretch. FIERCE AND STRONG tracked the early pace between runners, shuffled back into the turn, coaxed three to four wide to the quarter pole, no late response. KALAHARI NOT SORRY settled inside, got caught in tight and checked on the run to the turn, trailed to upper stretch and failed to threaten. TALENTED MAN chased the early pace from between rivals, ran in pursuit from the two path nearing the quarter marker then weakened. SHOWTIME MATINEE chased from inside, dropped back nearing the quarter marker, lost action late in the stretch, fell after crossing the finish, walked onto the equine ambulance following the race and was vanned off.

JES SEE ME broke alertly then ceded the early lead, prompted the decent pace into the backstretch, vied between rivals to upper stretch, took command into the final furlong, drifted out and carried out RESOLUTE to the final sixteenth while under firm left handed urging, held the runner-up at bay to deep stretch and proved best. RESOLUTE was forwardly placed while outside of rivals, tracked the decent pace three wide heading to the half-mile marker, chased three wide to the quarter marker then vied to upper stretch, was carried out by the drifting JES SEE ME into the drive, was kept at bay into the final sixteenth and held safely for second. CLASSIC NOFTY settled in the second flight, chased three wide to the quarter marker then angled four wide for the stretch drive, angled in behind the leading pair past mid-stretch, needed more to the final sixteenth but was clear in the end for third. BARTLETT sent for the early lead, took command and set a decent pace to the backstretch, dictated terms to the far turn, kicked clear into upper stretch, kept to task to the final sixteenth, felt late pressure from SPELLCAST and held at the wire over the oncoming runner-up. SPELLCAST forwardly placed, got shuffled back a bit into the first turn, settled along the inside to the backstretch then tracked the solid pace to the far turn, tipped out to upper stretch, ran in pursuit of BARTLETT into the lane, finished well but missed for the win while besting the rest. CRISPER unhurried to the backstretch, weaved through foes into the far turn then chased from the inside to upper stretch, closed willingly to the final sixteenth, couldn't reel in the leading pair into deep stretch but was a clear third. VERSUS settled off of the early pace then caught a bit in tight along the rail approaching the first turn, settled to the backstretch, moved to the outside of runners into the far turn, asked for run four wide into the stretch, lacked a final response and finished evenly. IDRATHERBEBLESSED settled in the second flight, tracked the decent pace two to three wide into the backstretch, bid three then two wide into the far turn, was outkicked to upper stretch and weakened in the final stages. MISTER WOODFORD close up to the early pace, went up to stalk three then two wide into the backstretch run, chased between rivals heading to the far turn then lost ground nearing the quarter marker, trailed to upper stretch and tired in the drive.

ENDLESS GLOW broke alertly then took back, shifted to the rail along the backstretch and was well placed approaching the turn, split rivals nearing the quarter marker then vied to upper stretch, took command into the lane and kicked clear at the furlong pole, drew off into the final furlong then was ridden out to the wire and won as much the best. ALL FUN N GAMES close up to the early pace, stalked the leading pair along the backstretch, took command three wide into the turn and led at the quarter pole, overtaken by ENDLESS GLOW into upper stretch and outkicked at the furlong marker, was no match late for the winner but held well in the end for second. I'MAMATERIALGIRL broke out and bumped SHE'S BANKABLE leaving the start, rated off of the contested early pace and tracked between rivals heading to the turn, got caught in tight at the three-eighths marker and was shuffled back along the turn, fought on into upper stretch, was caught in a bit of traffic to the furlong pole, angled out and was outfinished for second, while holding safely for third. SHIVA PARVATI stumbled at the start and was last away from the gate, shifted out to be widest along the backstretch run, improved position approaching the turn, was widest into the bend, chased four wide nearing the quarter marker then bid four wide to upper stretch, couldn't keep pace with the winner into the stretch drive, flattened out late and was outfinished for the minor awards. ROSESFORTHEQUEEN hard to load, broke in leaving the start and crowded an inner rival, vied for the early lead then engaged with HEDERA and dueled for pace duties outside of that foe along the backstretch, disputed the pace into the turn, was overtaken nearing the quarter marker, couldn't find more to upper stretch and weakened in the drive. SHE'S BANKABLE bumped at the start, lacked early speed and trailed to the turn, was last at the quarter marker, swung two to three wide to upper stretch and did not factor in the drive. HEDERA crowded at the start and off a step slow, went up to dispute the early pace from the inside, dueled inside of ROSESFORTHEQUEEN heading into the turn, lost position nearing the quarter pole, had little left into upper stretch then came up empty in the drive.
