FIRST SHOT FIRED stalked in the four path, bid in the three path midway around the far turn, took command in the four path at the top of the lane, and drew clear. VALORE pressed in the three path, was ridden in the two path around the far turn, angled out to the five path at the top of the stretch, and chased on to clearly be second best. RIVERBOAT BANDIT trailed in the four path, was driven in the two path around the far turn, and finished evenly in the three path down the lane for show. SASSE'S CLASS tracked in the three path, swung out to the six path turning into the stretch, and faded. MAYBE IT'S TIME set the pace in the two path but yielded in the final furlong. GOLD ASPEN had an awkward start, chased in the five path but weakened.
