## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

REDO raced mid pack, advanced to the turn, rallied four wide, got a head in front in the upper stretch, drew off and was kept to task. STANDPOINT was never far off the pace, swung wide leaving the turn, found his best stride late and got up for place while no threat to the winner. QUAMASH raced in hand early, set the pace to the upper stretch, was unable to sustain his bid and settled for show. ANNIHILATE 'EM broke out, stalked the pace, rallied on the turn to challenge for the lead and came up empty late. LUCKY DOUBLE ZERO was unhurried early, saved ground, bid along the rail on the turn and failed to rally. KING REIGERT stalked the pace to the second turn, dropped back and flattened out. KATISCHUO broke out and was outrun in an even effort. LEMON BREEZE pressed the pace to the second turn, tired and gave way. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
