Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

THE BULLION BOMBER (IRE) bumped with an inner foe at the start, rated in the three path, split foes while being put to a drive passing the quarter, bid from the four path at the top of the lane, and drew away in the final sixteenth. DECLARATION TIME had a slow start, trailed from the two path into the turn, angled out to the five path under a drive at the top of the stretch, and rallied for place. CHEERS FOR KITTEN pressed the pace in the three path, bid passing the quarter, got out-finished by an outer pair, but edged show. BOSS HOLIDAY broke out at the start bumping an outer foe, led in the two path, was cued along the inside midway around the turn, but evened out in the final furlong. BRADITUDE got bumped at the start by an inner foe, tracked in the two path but flattened in the four path down the lane. MARATHONER chased in the five path but made no closing bid. NAUTICAL NATURE bumped with an outer foe at the start, stalked in the four path but faded. NITRO TIME prompted the pace in the four path, floated out to the six path at the top of the lane, and yielded.
