CRUISING GAL was allowed to settle early, made a four wide move on the turn and continued that move to edge clear in the final sixteenth to prove best under a drive. DON DIVA set the pace on the inside and shook clear on the turn and remained clear to the furlong marker but was caught by the winner and had to settle for second best. SAY NO MORE chased the early pace and moved to the inside on the turn and cut the corner leaving the bend and had a mild late kick gaining the show award. NEW BOOTS stalked the pace three wide and lacked the needed bid losing the show award late. ELEANOR RIGBY was reserved early on the inside, eased out on the turn and came five wide into the lane and had a belated rally. CAYUGA was out-sprinted early and raced four wide on the turn and came six wide into the lane and never threatened. GOLDEN LIMONCELLO prompted the pace early two wide and weakened in the drive.
