TROPANDHAGEN was away alertly to set the pace while racing off the inside, drew clear three wide on the turn and then remained clear to the wire to prove best, driving. BEJUCO tracked the pace along the inside and advanced on the turn, moved out leaving the turn but proved to be no match for the winner while clearly second best. BIGTONTEN was allowed to settle early, moved out and came sic wide into the lane and was up for the show award late. BUZZ ADAMS stalked the winner three wide early and chased that rival three to four wide on the turn and came five wide into the lane and faded losing the show award on the wire. GENTLE BREEZE stumbled at the break and was bumped, settled early and moved to the inside, advanced nearing the quarter pole and swung out four wide leaving the turn but flattened out. SUNSHINE JOHNNY was settled early and raced three to two wide on the turn and was not a threat.
