DIVER tracked the pacesetters from the fence to the far turn, angled out to the clear on the bend to assume command at the quarter pole and drew off in the stretch unthreatened. MR. COLOSSAL dropped in to the rail into the first turn, saved ground on both bend, tipped out four wide turning for home and rallied willingly in the lane to gain the place. RACHAEL'S WAGON reserved off the pace racing between rivals at the back of the field and showed good late interest with a stretch rally. PARTY AT THE BEACH set the pace on a well measured lead to midway on the far turn, had no response when engaged nearing the quarter pole and weakened in the lane. KING REIGERT passed tiring rivals. RED FERN tracked the leaders for three-quarters and came up empty for the stretch run. STRATEGYFORYOU pressed the pace for five-eighths and gave way.
