VINSANITY hustled to the lead several strides away from the gate, set a well measured pace on a clear lead, responded when called upon in upper stretch and kicked away definitively. STARGAZZERS DREAM raced along the rail near the rear of the field down the backside, dropped back a bit when in tight quarters along the fence at the half mile pole, circled the field rallying on the turn and closed well six wide to be second best. CHIPS LEGACY prompted the pacesetter to the quarter pole, chased that one down the lane and failed to gain while holding the show as best of the rest. STONE'S THROW tracked the leaders from four wide to the head of the lane and failed to sustain his bid finishing evenly. CAMILO was well placed in contention to the top of the lane, made a mild bid in upper stretch and flattened out. BET ON BRET was not a factor.
