HIGHTAIL FOX reserved off the pace to track the leaders to the turn, rallied with a steady advance to mid-stretch and found his best stride late, surging in the final fifty yards to be up in time. SO GRAND sped to the lead shortly from the gate, opened a clear lead while setting a fast pace, widened the advantage through the turn and was caught late when tiring inside the sixteenth pole. ALABAMA SLEEPER stalked the early pace to the turn, lost ground on the bend as the pacesetter extended the lead and finished with a mild rally to pick up the show. ALEXANDER K raced near the rear of the field to the head of the lane and showed some late interest passing weaker rivals in the stretch. VIOLIN FINGERS went evenly never posing a threat. LEO Q chased the fast pace for a half mile and faded in the lane.
