PROTOTYPE pressed the pace to the head of the stretch, responded well in upper stretch to take the lead at the eighth pole and prevailed in a determined drive. IRISH STONE tracked the from the inside racing just behind the leading duo, waited in upper stretch for racing room, angled out four wide midway down the lane and rallied well to be gaining gradually on the winner late. CHUBS ROCKET rated at the rear of the compact field along the rail, angled to the outside and registered a late gain from six wide in deep stretch to get the show. MO DODGY set the pace under constant pressure, battled on the lead to midway down the lane and weakened in the final eighth. SIXTEEN CIGARETTES tracked the leaders from five wide to the turn, rallied to threaten at the quarter pole and flattened out coming home.
