DISPOSABLE INCOME waited in gate for loose horse, bumped at the start by inside rival to be last away, raced up to a stalking position down the backstretch, rallied to engage the leader from three wide on the turn, took command in upper stretch and asserted himself as much the best through the lane. STARK COUNTY waited in gate for loose horse, reserved off the pace along the fence down the backside, rallied under an early drive on the turn and continued a steady gain to be second best. VIOLIN FINGERS was slow early to be the trailer and found his best stride late with a belated bid in the lane to be up for the show. JUDY CHOP waited in gate for loose horse, was prominently placed to prompt the pace and finished evenly lacking a a response for the drive. SO GRAND waited in the gate for loose horse, set the pace under mild pressure, had no answer when challenged at the quarter pole and gave way in the stretch. FAAZ waited in gate for loose horse, chased the leaders from five wide through the turn and dropped out failing to ever threaten. ALABAMA SLEEPER threw the rider as attempting to load, ran loose in the chute pre-race while most of the field waited in the gate for minutes, was re-mounted, broke alertly, showed brief speed and faltered dropping to the rear on the turn.
