PANCHO SLIPS AWAY sped up the fence to the lead shortly from the gate, quickly went clear, drifted out turning for home, maintained that advantage to upper stretch, was collared in a four way charge at the eighth pole, briefly lost the lead and came again gamely to prevail. PARTY AT THE BEACH reserved off the pace early along the inside, cut the corner turning for home and surged late to be gaining in the late going. SHANNONIA stalked the leader through the turn, rallied tipping out around the pacesetter turning for home, was carried out to the five path by that one, dug-in to loom in midstretch and was outkicked in the final fifty yards. AROUET was well placed just off the clear leader to the turn, edged closer on the bend, circled six wide at the top of the lane to rally for a brief lead in mid-stretch and was outfinished in the final eighth when unable to sustain that rally. SILVER ORE chased throughout never mounting a bid. OH' WHAT A DAY dwelt at the gate giving th efield a half dozen lengths from the gate and was never a factor.
