OHOPEE set the pace on a clear well rated lead to the head of the lane, kicked away in upper stretch and was never challenged as a no doubt victor. NEW ISSUE unhurried early to race along the inside at the back of the field, was caught behind a wall of runners through the turn while stuck at the back, waited patiently for racing room, cut the corner in the clear at the top of the stretch and closed well with a late gain. COURAGEOUS ARI tracked the leaders from the inside through the turn and rallied with a mild bid in the lane to be best of the rest. JOYS OF SUMMER chased the pacesetter through the turn and faded. JASMINES WORLD ranged up from the rear of the field four wide on the turn with an early bid and flattened out coming home. SIP'N' SPEED went evenly failing to menace.
