GUN POLICY prompted the pace for a half mile, closed the gap from between rivals two wide on the turn to take command nearing the quarter pole, kicked clear in upper stretch and was unthreatened down the lane. GRAB THE SPARK stalked the pace from four wide to midway on the far turn, rallied to loom turning for home, was no match for the winner and ran-on willingly as second best. TINSELTOWN tracked the leaders racing along the inside of the second duo, was set to a drive early on the final turn and finished with a grinding bid to be along for the show. WETLANDS WILLY trailed for three-quarters, swung five wide turning for home and passed tiring rivals in the lane without impact. LEO Q set the pace under mild pressure for a half through slow fractions and gave way when challenged at the quarter pole. NOBLE HERO was reserved racing three wide within striking distance to the three-eighths pole, failed to repond when called upon and faded from contention.
