DRIVE BY JOHNNY hard held for the first half mile to prompt the pace from three wide, rallied to the lead on the far turn, drifted to the five path battling on the lead in upper stretch, was bumped hard being nearly knocked off stride by the runner-up, straightened away digging back in, came together again at the sixteenth pole with rival and prevailed in a determined drive. WETLANDS WILLY set a slow pace on a clear early lead, responded willingly when engaged by the winner nearin the quarter pole while racing in the two path, bore out midway down the lane to bump the winner sideways, dropped back in away from the challenger, came together again late in the lane when winner came in and this one drifted out again and was denied in the final strides. GLEAMING reserved saving ground along the inside, rallied mildly without impact on the top pair, drifted out down the lane and held the show. CHANNEL ME IN slow early to be the trailer, remained at the rear to midway on the far turn, circled six wide coming for home and showed some late interest. MR. IMPATIENT went evenly failing to menace. DOUBLE UP LARRY chased the leaders for five-eighths and faded on the far turn. THE TRAINER OF THE RUNNER-UP CLAIMED FOUL FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH BY THE WINNER, UPON REVIEW THE STEWARDS MADE NO CHANGE.
