BOTITA unhurried in the early going to be near the rear of the field, rallied circling eight wide at the head of the stretch and closed with a late rush to be up in time. ROCK TUNE pressed the pace to the top of the lane, kept grinding to wear down the pacesetter inside the sixteenth pole and was outkicked by the winner in the final strides. DEDOS set the pace on a well rated lead, battled with the runner-up in the lane holding the advantage until late and was outfinished while weakening in the final hundred yards. COLLECTIVE NATION tracked the leaders through the turn and rallied mildly down the lane to hit the board. LIGHTNING LANE was well placed saving ground along the inside, cut the corner coming for home and but in a late bid to share the spot. NEW DIAMOND missed the bread to be the trailer and passed weaker rivals in the stretch. QUITE CONTINENTAL went evenly failing to menace. WINDY VALLEY stalked the pace to midway on the turn and came up empty. KATHLYNS PHALANX broke well, dropped steadily back, bore out on the turn, was eased to the wire and walked off.
