NUTS AND BOLTS broke well to take command from the gate, set a well rated, well measured pace to the far turn, edged clear on the far turn and kicked away in upper stretch when called upon. BAYTOWN STORM unhurried to be the early trailer, commenced a steady rally on the final bend saving ground along the inside, angled out to the clear in upper stretch and finished willingly as second best. HITS DIFFERENT reserved off the pace to be the trailer, circled the field coming for home and put in a belated bid to be along for the show. LUCY PLAYA stalked the pace to the far turn, chased the winner turning for home unable to gain on that one and finshied evenly. NEW ISSUE raced near the rear of the field early, made an middle move to be closing the gap on the far turn and flattened out unable to sustain the bid. WICKEDTHISWAYCOMES pressed the pace for the first half mile and came up empty.
