LITTLE MARTHA reserved off the pace for the first half mile, edged closer to striking distance along the rail on the far turn, waited for racing room turning for home, angled three wide to the clear and quickly pulled away in the final furlong. INANNA'S QUEST unhurried to the race at the rear of the main body of the field, made a steady advance commencing midway on the final turn and continued to churn through the lane to be up for the place in deep stretch. LADY HAMILTON set the pace on a clear lead through the first turn, remained the pacesetter while well rated to the quarter pole, responded when challenged turning for home and was outkicked in the final eighth. KITTEN'S WAR prompted the pace down the backside, rallied to take a lead in mid-stretch dueling with the leader in the lane and weakened late. HIGHLAND HOLIDAY tracked the leaders to the far turn and lacked a response when called upon. VANILLA BEAN stalked the leaders to be well placed and came up empty on the final bend fading from contention. CABERNET was not a factor.
