JENADRIYAH reserved off the quick pace to midway on the turn, commenced a steady bid approaching the quarter pole to take a short lead in mid-stretch and drew clear in deep stretch. TWO SCOOPS slow early to be the trailer, rallied turning for home and mounted a good belated bid to be up for the place. OH SHEILA tracked the leaders into the turn, rallied to threaten turning for home and finished evenly unable to match the top pair. SWEET CAROL JAMES prompted the pace down the backstretch, rallied to loom at the top of the lane, chased through the stretch and was outkicked late. BOUJIE BETZ went evenly failing to menace. TIGER EYE PEARL flashed brief speed to stalk the leaders early and faded. SPOKEN VOW set the pace under pressure to the quarter pole and gave way turning for home.
