POPCORN N PEACHES stalked the pace through the turn, rallied five wide in upper stretch, wore the leaders down in mid-stretch and pulled clear unthreatened late. HONORANDAPRAYER unhurried to be the trailer in the field and mounted a good, belated bid down the lane to be up for the place. VOODOO prompted the early pace, moved to challenge from three wide on the turn, vied for the lead to the eighth pole and weakened in the final furlong. MAYHEM sped to aa clear lead steps from the gate, dueled on the lead from the quarter pole to midway down the lane and tired in the final eighth. TWIRLAWAY tracked the leaders for a half mile and finished evenly lacking a closing bid. BACK THE CRICK bore out bolting to the outside fence from the break, was eased on the turn and was removed from the track by an equine ambulance as a precaution.

T' RAY set a slow pace on a well rated, well measured lead, repelled the challengers turning for home to kick away when called upon and held on late to prevail. WETLANDS WILLY prompted the pace for five eighths, made a rally commencing midway on the turn and was steadily edging closer inside the final furlong tto be gaining late. MANON stalked the pace the entire way, rallied nearing the quarter pole to loom in upper stretch and kept-on through the lane unable to gain position. MR. IMPATIENT trailed to the far turn and passed weaker rivals without impact coming home. DOUBLE UP LARRY went evenly failing to menace. TALKIN TOUGH raced in contention for the first half mile and steadily faded to be outrun.

TRIPLE START unhurried to trail for the first half mile, commenced a rally on the outside midway on the far turn, circled tthe field five wide turning for home and closed well to be pulling away convincingly in the final furlong. HOLD YOUR APPLAUSE prompted the pace to the final turn, rallied to close the gap on the bend, took the lead in upper stretch, was no match for the winner and ran-on willingly as second best. ENJOY THE MUSIC stalked the leaders from the rail through the far turn to be well placed turning for home and failed to gain through the lane. BET ON BRET rated in mid-pack down the backstretch, rallied four wide on the final turn to loom up and flattened out in the lane unable to sustain the bid. MAJOR THOMAS raced a the rear of the field to be the trailer on the far turn, circled wide and showed some late interest without impact. REVOLUTIONNAIRE (FR) set a slow pace on a clear, comfortable lead to the final bend and steadily gave way through the lane.

IPLEDTHEFIFTH pressed the pace from the half mile pole to the top of the stretch, dueled inside the eighth pole and pulled away late. TROPHY HUSBAND sprinted off to a wide advantage in the first turn, was throttled down on the backstretch allowing the field to shrink the margin, held the lead through the turn, vied with the winner down the lane and gave way grudgingly in the final sixteenth.
