IPLEDTHEFIFTH pressed the pace from the half mile pole to the top of the stretch, dueled inside the eighth pole and pulled away late. TROPHY HUSBAND sprinted off to a wide advantage in the first turn, was throttled down on the backstretch allowing the field to shrink the margin, held the lead through the turn, vied with the winner down the lane and gave way grudgingly in the final sixteenth. SNOWSTORM stalked the pace from three wide to the final turn, rallied four wide to loom turning for home and kept-on through the lane going evenly. NOBLE HERO reserved in mid-pack off the slow pace, circled rallying six wide at the head of the lane and put in a mild bid through the stretch. ALEXANDER K was well placed saving ground and rallied up the inside with some late interest in the lane. GLEAMING failed to menace. SAINT SOLOMON was not a threat. VIOLIN FINGERS was never a factor.
