## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

NIGHT NURSE set a well rated pace on a well measured lead to the far turn, repelled a challenge nearing the quarter pole to hold the lead through the lane while digging-in gamely and held the closer safe late. SPARKLING RUBY reserved off the pace racing in mid-pack, circled six wide turning for home and closed willingly to be gaining late. HAUT LES COEURS prompted the pace while well held down the backstretch, rallied to threaten at the quarter pole, failed to pass the winner turning for home and ran-on well through the lane to hold the show. LIZZIE BABY unhurried to be near the rear through the far turn, cut the corner coming home and rallied with a late bid. LA CREMA stalked the pace through the far turn, kept-on in upper stretch and lacked a closing kick. AZTEC PRINCESS tracked th leaders down the backisde, rallied nearing the three-eighths pole with an early bid and flattened out turning for home. CRYSTAL WATER trailed as a non-factor.
