CALVIN'S RIDE raced off the pacesetter through the first turn, moved up to press the leader down the backside, rallied to challenge on the far turn, took the lead turning for home, kicked clear in upper stretch and held the closer safe late. MAYNARD reserved to race near the rear o the field to midway on the far turn, rallied turning for home putting in a belated bid in the lane to be gaining rapidly late. ALEMAN tracked the leaders down the backside, closed the gap on the final turn, angled five wide to loom in mid-stretch and finished evenly unable to sustain the rally. HAPPYISASHAPPYDOES set the pace on a clear lead through the first turn, came under steady pressure down the backside and lacked a finishing response weakening in the stretch. SECRET TROUBLE was not a factor. BLESS AMERICA stalked the pace for five-eighths and faded.
