## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

BURNIN TURF set the pace on a well rated, well measured lead, responded when called upon turning for home to kick clear and held the closer safe late in the drive. MACKENZIE'S NOVVA tracked the leaders from the inside, closed the gap down the backside to be on the winner's heels, waited on the turn losing ground and rallied well in the lane to be second best. FERRARI KID stalked the pacesetter to the far turn, rallied chasing the winner on the bend unable to pass and kept-on down the lane to hold the show as best of the rest. MIDNIGHT AMBITION went evenly failing to menace. COX CANYON trailed to the stretch and never posed a threat. THE DOORMAN raced in contention in mid-pack for a half and came up empty on the turn faded to the rear.
