YOUREAWIZARD HARRY settled well off the pace near the back of the field to the far turn, commenced a rally midway on the far turn, swung out six wide for the drive and prevailed in a determined drive. DUCK HUNTER rated in mid-pack for five-eighths, closed the gap on the turn, rallied strongly to the lead in upper stretch and was nailed in the final strides in a good effort. STANDPOINT slow early to be the distant trailer,improved narrowing the gap traveling with the winner, rallied seven wide and finished well. DRUNKLE tracked the leaders saving ground along the inside, was hard held down the backstretch, was well placed nearing the quarter pole while full of run but held up looking for clear racing room and surged too late when finally an opening wide enough for the rider appeared late. MACKENZIE'S NOVVA prompted the pace through the turn, was prominent in upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. BIG RUN set the pace on a well measured lead to midway on the far turn and had no answer when challenged turning for home, tiring in the late going. CHILL BOSS stalked the pace for three-quarters and failed to respond when called upon giving way in the stretch.
