RACHAEL'S WAGON was slow early when tangled up with rival to the outside, settled at the back under patient handling, closed ground on the far turn while saving ground, cut the corner turning for home and rallied well up the inside to be going away near the wire. MR. COLOSSAL tracked the leaders to be well placed midway on the final bend, idled in upper stretch and found best stride late to be gaining. GIDEON hesitated and broke in a tangle bumping rival to the inside, straightened away to race near the rear having given the field a couple lengths, remained at the back to midway on the final turn and rallied with good late interest. LEE THE CABBY set the pace under mild pressure while well rated to the far turn, edged away on the bend to still control turning for home and weakened through the stretch. GRAB THE SPARK chased the leaders from four wide to stalk the pace and faded in the final quarter mile. T' RAY pressed the pace to the far turn and steadily gave way.
