MOMENTOUS MISS prompted the pace to midway on the turn, rallied nearing the quarter pole to take command turning for home, finished well through the lane and just held on the bob at the wire. MISS FOXANN settled to rate off the pace between rivals down the backstretch, rallied on the turn with a steady bid angling six wide at the top of the lane and continued to close the gap in a good effort losing the head bob on the line. LA CREMA reserved off the pace at the back of the field, rallied turning for home from five wide, angled in through traffic looking for racing room and surged along the inside in the final hundred yards with a belated bid. MAKE A MILLION tracked the leaders from four wide through the turn, rallied in upper stretch to loom and finished evenly lacking a closing kick. ISLANDINTHESTREAM set the pace on a clear lead early under mild pressure, responded willingly when challenged turning for home and weakened in the final eighth. ONE SPECIAL ACT angled in to the rail in the first quarter to stalk the leaders from the fence, angled out on the turn to threaten and flattened out. WHAT'S GOOD was not a factor.
