FLOAT AWAY pressed the pace from the rail to the half mile pole racing three abreast, angled off the pacesetters heels to the two path nearing the three-eighths bumping RED HOT SPARK causing that one to take up from between rivals, assumed command early on the turn, angled back to the inside at the five-sixteenths causing the early pacesetter to steady, kicked away turning for home and was unthreatened in the lane. LADY HAMILTON tracked the pacesetter from five wide down the backside, rallied approaching the quarter pole, failed to gain on the winner in the stretch and ran-on as second best. RED HOT SPARK stalked the leader from between rivals down the backside, was bumped as the winner angled off the rail nearing the three-eighths pole having to steady losing position, quickly recovered and finished evenly lacking a late kick. INANNA'S QUEST was not a threat. WATERLOO SUNSET broke alertly to set the pace on a clear early lead, lost the lead early on the turn, steadied as the winner dropped in midway on the bend and gave way coming home. THE RIDERS OF RED HOT SPARK AND WATERLOO SUNSET BOTH CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER FOR INTERFERENCE AT DIFFERENT POINTS ON THE TURN, UPON REVIEW THE STEWARDS MADE NO CHANGE CITING LACK OF CONCLUSIVE VIDEO EVIDENCE.
