## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

CHILL BOSS rated in mid-pack to the far turn, rallied on the bend six wide to take control quickly and drew off unchallenged in the lane. NOBLE STAR reserved off the pace down the backside, rallied on the turn following the winner, chased that one down the lane and was along for the place. SPECTACULAR LUCK slow early to be the trailer, commenced a steady bid on the final turn and closed willingly with a belated gain. BREATH DEEPLY tracked the leaders down the backside, rallied on the turn to be prominent, was no match for the winner and finished evenly unable to sustain the bid. SNOVEMBER raced in the rear half of the field to the top ofthe lane and showed some interest in the lane without impact. TWELVETWO pressed the early pace, moved up three wide down the backstretch to take the lead, held the advantage to midway on the turn and weakened. DR. DARBY passed tiring rivals. WATERMELON CRUSH set the pace under pressure to midway down the backside and steadily gave way when challenged. BRADY made an early bid down the backside to press the pace from five wide briefly and was through early. PALACE REVOLT was not a factor.
