SETTLING STORM reserved off the pace to the far turn, commenced a steady advance on the bend, swept up six wide to take command in upper stretch and drew clear. MO SENSE unhurried to race near the rear of the field to midway on the far turn, rallied turning for home, angled out to the clear in mid-stretch and found his best stride late to be gaining in deep stretch. LITTLE MARTHA tracked the leaders from five wide, rallied on the final turn to be with the leader in upper stretch, was no match for the winner and ran-on evenly. MAKE A MILLION sped to the lead into the first turn, set a quick temp with only mild pressure and weakened turning for home. DOROTEA DREAM slow early to trail and passed tiring rivals coming home. SOUPER AMUSING was rank down the straight for the first time pulling against restraint, settled to stalk the pace down the backside, threatened at the quarter pole and gave way in the lane. IPANEMA PRINCESS (IRE) tugged down the backstretch while rated in mid-pack and was through early. WARRIOR'S DEFENSE prompted the pace for a half mile and faded.
