VALIANT VICTORIA set the pace under mild pressure to midway on the turn, kicked away nearing the quarter pole and widened through the stretch in a hand ride as much the best. RUNAWAY BREEZE tracked the leader from the inside through the turn, cut the corner turning for home and finished well to be second best. ECHO SEVEN stalked the pace from three wide to the quarter pole, swept up five wide with a bid at the top of the lane and ran-in willingly. TEAM FEISTY prompted the pace to midway on the turn, failed to gain on the pacesetter when called upon and weakened in the stretch. WILD LOOKER went evenly and never was a threat. LIGHT HEARTED was outrun.
