KOBE'S CAUSE pressed the pace up the backstretch, continued to force the issue around the turn, was set down two wide at the head of the lane, dueled outside of C R INSTA GATOR past mid-stretch then shook free and edged away. FREDDY J came away last at the start and settled in the back while never far from the frontend, was ridden three wide around the turn, continued hard ridden four paths wide into the lane, finished with response and gained second best. C R INSTA GATOR sped to the lead at the start, set a pressured pace up the backstretch and continued to hold a slight edge around the turn, took on the challenge from KOBE'S CAUSE at the head of the lane, fought back past mid-stretch then weakened late. ROCKIN BOOTS was a bit keen in opening stages then settled into tracking position, hustled along three wide around the turn and into the drive and responded evenly. SPANISH KISS settled in contention saving ground, given cue along the rail at the head of the lane, briefly gained a threatening position but failed to sustain bid. FREEDOM TO SPEED was not far back early on, hustled along the outside into the upper stretch and failed to move on.
