BEN FRANKLIN was unhurried and raced in the back, swung into action four to five wide entering the upper stretch, given cue, responded gamely, rallied along the outside and got up late. MERONEY set a pressured pace, vied late on the turn, edged away past upper stretch, continued to lead the way then got caught late. SPEECHLESS was forwardly placed, continued to track the top pair around the turn, came under right handed pressure approaching the eighth pole, ran on and just lasted for show. MAVERAMA settled and saved ground around the turn, given cue at the head of the lane, tipped two wide and gained late. R N R AUDIBLE raced off the pace, was ridden three to four wide into the lane and had a mild improve. COPPER ECHO raced in range, ran on four wide into the lane then evened out late. DOUBLE ECHO prompted the early pace, continued in close range into the final furlong then gave way. MARINARA SAUCED failed to move into contention.
