HELADO vied three wide for the early lead, continued to match strides outside of SHUT UP MAN around the turn, shook free at the head of the lane, quickly widened to a clear advantage and kept to task. LEAPIN TY MAN came away last and settled outside in range, given cue three wide at the head of the lane, edged closer under right handed pressure and produced a solid finish. UNCLE SINGH vied four paths wide in opening stages, steadied slightly entering the turn, weakened off the top flight but remained in contention, ran on two wide down the lane and secured a share. SHUT UP MAN vied for the lead soon after the start, matched strides inside of HELADO around the turn, could not move on with the eventual winner at the head of the lane and flattened out. NINETEEN HUNDRED vied inside of rivals in opening stages, could not match strides mid-way around the turn and steadily faded. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
