MIGHTY KOA vied three deep up the backstretch, shook free near the quarter pole, hustled along two wide into the drive and held late. FALLEN STAR was allowed to settle in the opening quarter, circled up three wide at the quarter pole, sustained a steady three to four wide effort down the lane and edged closer to the wire. TOUGH TOMMY tracked the top trio along the rail, sat patiently for a clear path late on the backstretch, made some contact with RUB THE GREEN around the turn, tipped two wide for the drive, came out a path wider and gained late. RUB OF THE GREEN vied between rivals up the backstretch, weakened nearing the three furlong marker, made contact with TOUGH TOMMY around the turn, weakened, launched a rebid at the head of the lane and lacked a needed rally. BORN FEARLESS vied inside of duo in the opening quarter, remained in contention to the furlong marker then gave way. INTO THE DEEP was not too back early lead, went three wide around the turn, swung wider into the drive and failed to move on. STEWARDS POSTED AN INQUIRY AND RIDER OF RUB OF THE GREEN LODGED CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST TOUGH TOMMY FOR INTERFERENCE AROUND THE TURN, AFTER REVIEW NO ACTION WAS TAKEN
