FIRST BID saved ground around the first turn and settled just off the early pace, angled out and hustled along three wide approaching the quarter pole, hustled along three wide into the lane, dug in under firm handling and cleared late. PARKWAY raced two wide into into the first turn, was forwardly placed three wide up the backstretch, headed in pursuit nearing the far turn, cleared the lead leaving the five sixteenths pole, ran on under steady encouragement and got collared late. REBELIOUS set a pressured pace around the first turn and continued with a slim lead up the backstretch, got headed by PARKWAY leaving the mid-way point around the turn, ran on into upper stretch then weakened and held show. THAT'S SOMETHING pressed the pace around the first turn, continued to force the issue up the backstretch then weakened late on the far turn. BOURBON LIFE saved ground and failed to move into contention.
