BOCA GUY broke on top and opened up around the first turn, continued to set the uncontested pace in hand, took on a pair of challengers nearing the quarter pole, dueled inside into upper stretch, got headed for the lead, dug in gamely, took back a slim lead and held sway. BATTLE CRUISER settled around the first turn, rated just off mid-pack, saved ground around the far turn, tipped three wide for the drive, advanced into striking distance, edged closer approaching the wire but failed to get by the game winner. MR. THUNDERSTRUCK tracked the pace up the backstretch, advanced to challenge BOCA GUY for the lead approaching the quarter pole, fought gamely into upper stretch, got a head in front then got collared and yielded late. PAPA FUNNY stalked the early pace, vied three wide at the quarter pole, remained in contention into the final furlong then weakened. CONTACT TRACING raced off the pace, swung four to five wide into upper stretch and lacked a rally. CLOUDY HOLIDAY never reached contention.
